Formaglini Vineyards is David de Lancellotti's Oregon estate wine inspired by his Italian heritage.

David brings a unique talent to both his wine growing style and his dedication to small hand-farmed Oregon Pinot Noir. True to the essence of the soil, the Formaglini Vineyard has used only Biodynamic and organic techniques since its planting in 2007. David is deeply passionate and faithful to his Italian roots and integrates these Old World learnings and practices throughout his Formaglini Vineyard wine experience.

Location – Chehalem Mountains AVA in the Willamette Valley of Oregon

Elevation – 400 feet

Soil – This dry-farmed site sits on a level bench of sedimentary sandy soil, which exhibits moderate water holding capacity and superior drainage.

Exposure – Southwest

Clones – 777, 828, 115 and Pommard Pinot Noir clones

- *Vintage 2012 Estate Pinot Noir – inaugural vintage released June 2014, 100 cases, SOLD in 90 days, 90-point rating via PinotFile
- *Vintage 2013 Estate Pinot Noir – 230 cases released June 2015, 93-point rating via Wine Spectator, 91-point rating via PinotFile.
- *Vintage 2013 Estate Insieme Cuvee - 50 cases, 75% Pinot Noir/25% Lagrein, SOLD OUT
- *Vintage 2014 Estate Pinot Noir – 150 cases, released fall 2016, 92-point rating from Wine Spectator
- *Vintage 2015 Estate Pinot Noir – 125 cases, releasing fall 2017
- *Vintage 2015 Insieme Cuvee – 50 cases, 75% Pinot Noir/25% Lagrein, releasing fall 2017
- *First white wine in 2017 with 50 cases of Chardonnay
